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学习英语要摆脱“应试”

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本报讯（记者 徐媛 实习生 梁顺）“中国学生学习英语时有一个独有的误区。”近日，华尔街英语创始人李文昊（Luigi T Peccenini）在湖南涉外经济学院“青年领导力系列讲座”上，提醒学生们学习英语要摆脱“应试”。

这位年逾古稀的意大利老者通晓六门外国语言，却自称“上辈子是中国人”，他对中国文化有着超乎常人的热爱，喜欢《道德经》。他非常乐意与中国学生交流，从2010年11月以来，先后在北京语言大学、北京大学等进行演讲。

“华尔街英语进入中国，也就两三个月的时间，我就发现中国学生身上有个典型的误区。”李文昊说，“中国的学生学习英语沉迷于把每一个词都翻译过来，死记硬背下来，而不是从语境中学习。其实理解词不是最重要的，理解语境才是最关键的。”李文昊打了个比方，学习英语就像在剧院里听歌剧一样，也许有可能有些个别的单词不理解，如果能够理解整个语境，重复几遍，词语的理解就不是问题了。

He reminded students to get rid of exam-oriented education.

This wise Italian man known about six foreign languages, but he said “I was Chinese in my past life”. He likes Chinese culture more than most of the people. For example he likes “Tao De Jing”. He loves to communicate with Chinese students. He conducted series campus seminars since November 2010, started from Peaking Language University, Peaking University and so on.

I’ve found a typical mistake of Chinese students who are learning English, when the time Wall Street English just entered into China market about two or three months. Pecce said. Chinese students like to translate every word, memorize them without understanding of the real meaning of the words and overall context. However, to fully understand the context is more important than anything else. Pecce shared an example – learning English is just like listening to opera in the theatre. Maybe there are few words that we don’t understand, but once we understand the context, repeat the words several times, then we can memorize them without any problems.
