

## 华尔街英语创始人: 学习英语应像听歌剧

李文昊建议,英语教学应像在剧院里听歌剧,也许在听的过程中有个别单词不懂,只要理解了整个语境,个别不理解的单词通过其它方法,重复几次,慢慢地就能理解。"理解这个词不是最重要的,理解语境才是最重要的。"
