

# Free English courses given to outstanding students

A total of 10 students at Shenzhen University have been rewarded for excelling academically. The students will receive free language training worth 319,000 yuan at Wall Street English.

The award is an attempt to encourage university students to improve their English through hard work and effective study methods, according to the training center.

The award was presented by Dr. Luigi Peccenini, founder and CEO of the center, when he gave a lecture at the university on Thursday.

In the lecture, Peccenini shared his thoughts about education. He also discussed the importance of studying hard and pursuing a dream.

It was the sixth leg of Peccenini's tour of China's universities. Since November 10, 2010, Peccenini has given lectures at top universities such as Beijing University and Beijing Foreign Languages University, Zhongshan University in Guangzhou and Nankai University in Tianjin, attracting more than 1,000 students.

His lectures mainly focus on popular issues such as business startup, moral values, learning and careers.

Meanwhile, Peccenini gave out free English courses worth 319,000 yuan to 10 outstanding students at each university, hoping they could

improve their English skills with professional help. So far, 40 students from across the country are taking the courses. Wall Street English also offered internships and job opportunities to those who were interested in English teaching or had financial difficulties. More universities would be included in the program.

"I have worked in education for more than 30 years and I thought I should repay society," said Peccenini after the lecture.
